As a parent/guardian of a student in New Hanover County Schools, I am writing this letter to let you know that Myrtle Grove Middle School, has been designated as a Targeted Support & Improvement Additional Targeted Support (TSI-AT) school by the North Carolina State Board of Education. As stated in ESSA Section 1111(d)(2), North Carolina had to identify schools for targeted support and improvement. TSI-AT schools in North Carolina are those that have a subgroup that is under-performing. The intent of this opportunity is to improve educational outcomes for all students, close achievement gaps, increase equity, and improve the quality of instruction.

As a TSI-AT school, Myrtle Grove Middle School is required to develop a comprehensive plan that specifically addresses how the school will improve student achievement. The plan will also include how our district will support us and monitor the progress of our school. The comprehensive plan will address the following areas:

- Classroom Management
- Standards-aligned Instruction
- Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)
- Instructional Leadership
- Recruitment & Retention of Effective Teachers
- Support for Grade-to-Grade Transitions
- Implementation of a Tiered Instructional System
- Data-Driven Decision Making
- Student Support Services
- Family and Community Engagement

We have set the following goals for_Myrtle Grove Middle School this year:

Students showing need for specially designed instruction will show an overall academic increase on Reading and Math EOG's by MGMS staff ensuring all units of instruction and activities are aligned with IEP goals and objectives.

Our students need to experience higher achievement levels, but it will require hard work on the part of staff, students and families. Here are some strategies Myrtle Grove Middle School will be implementing:

- Strengthening overall core instruction
- Providing addition time in core academics to identified students with IEP's
- Continuing a focus on effective co-teaching between special education teachers and regular classroom teachers.
